Important updates

As we move closer to the launch of HealthPathways in June 2025, work is well underway at each OHT to localize pathways for each region. The goal is to launch with 30 to 50 locally-relevant pathways available to clinicians, enabling them to deliver more efficient and effective care, improving patient outcomes across the healthcare system.

In addition to this work, the program management team has been actively engaging and will continue to engage Subject Matter Experts who provide input to ensure pathways reflects local practice.

In preparation for the launch, the program team, clinical leads, and clinical editors gathered for in-person training over two days in January. This training for all new HealthPathways programs teams was delivered by the Streamliners' Clinical Advisors (RGCA)

and focused on the key concepts, relationships, and processes that will establish a solid base for the HealthPathways program.
